



1900 WEST SEWER UPGRADE PROJECT

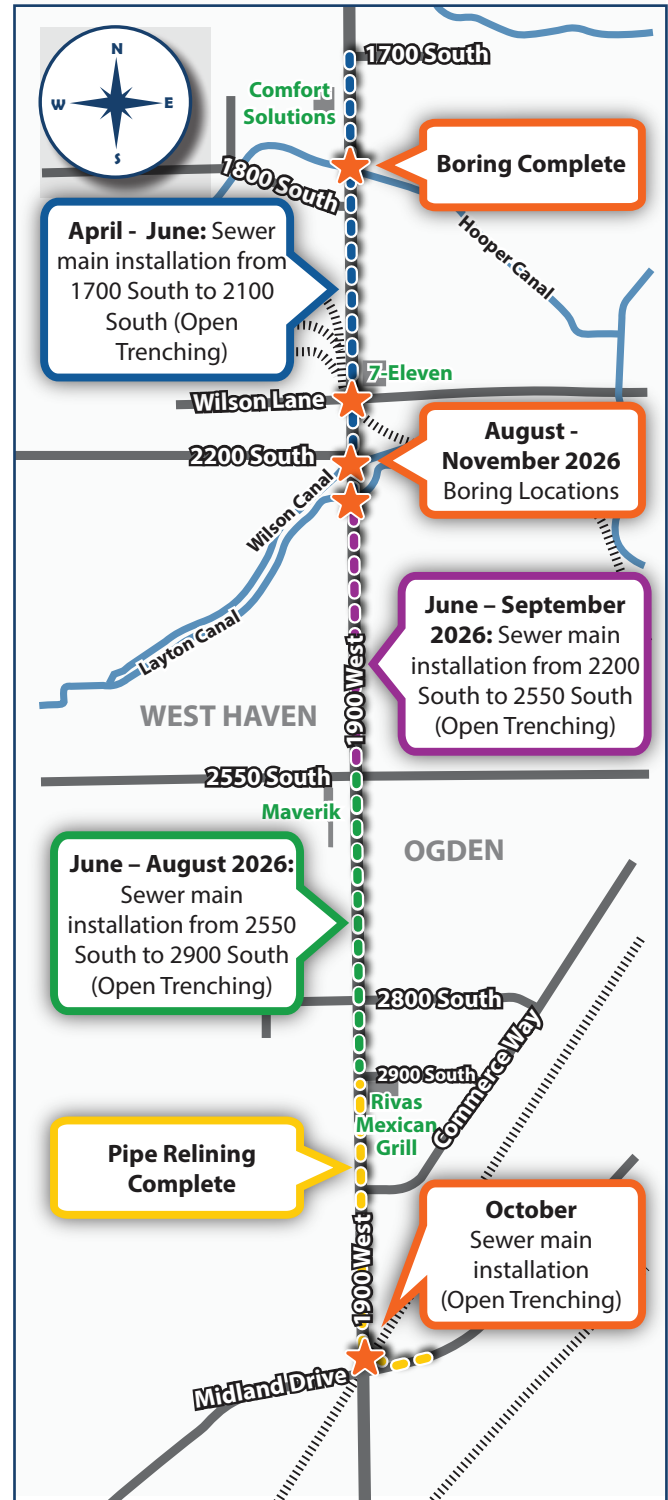
The Central Weber Sewer Improvement District continues sewer line upgrades along 1900 West in West Haven/Ogden between approximately 1700 South (Comfort Solutions) and Midland Drive. The project will rehabilitate a section of existing pipe on the southern end and remove and replace existing sewer manholes and pipes and install upsized pipes in the remainder to meet current and future wastewater/sewer collection needs. Project completion is expected by late spring 2027.

TENTATIVE SCHEDULE

*Schedules are subject to change due to weather conditions, equipment/supply issues and other unforeseen circumstances.

- **Now - June:** Sewer main installation (1700 South – 2100 South), open trenching
- **June - September:** Sewer main installation (2200 South - 2550 South), open trenching
- **June – August:** Sewer main installation (2550 South to 2900 South), open trenching
- **August – November:** Bore under Utah Central Railroad (UCRR at Wilson Lane), Wilson and Layton Canals at 2200 South
- **October:** Sewer main installation (Midland Drive), open trenching
- **May 2027:** Project completion

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CONSTRUCTION IMPACTS

- Traffic will be shifted to the east side of the road, with a goal to maintain two lanes of traffic in each direction in work zones. The center turn lane will be maintained where possible.
- Drivers should expect intermittent through and turn lane closures, flagging operations and temporary side-street closures with advance notice. Weekend and night work will be scheduled for major cross-street closures.
- Open trenching for sewer mainline work will be on the west side of 1900 West in the existing roadway shoulder between 1700 South and 2900 South.
- Beginning on the north and moving southward, sewer main installation will be phased in approximately 500-foot sections.
- Business and residential access will be maintained. With advance notice, properties on the west side of 1900 West should expect open trenching through driveways and temporary closures. Properties with multiple driveway accesses will have them closed one at a time.
- A temporary sewer bypass pipe will be in place in work zones.
- Businesses on both sides of 1900 West (1700 South - 2900 South only) should expect up to half-day sewer service interruptions with advance notice for connection to the new sewer main. This work will be scheduled following completion of mainline installation in each section.
- Crews will rehabilitate the existing sewer main between Midland Drive and 2900 South (Rivas Mexican Grill) which will not require open trenching or sewer service interruptions in this section.
- Underground boring operations will be used to cross under railroad lines and canals.
- Crews plan to work Monday through Friday from 7:30 a.m. – 5 p.m. with night and weekend work scheduled as needed.
- Motorists are advised to reduce speeds and watch for lane shifts in work zones.
- Utility service interruptions (other than sewer) are not planned with this project, however, advance notice will be provided if they become necessary.

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
